

SUMMER SCHOOL WORLD CULTURES & LITERATURES IN ENGLISH

Period: 17 - 22 September 2012 (arrival and departure on Sunday)

DESCRIPTION:

From Europe to a variety of World Literatures and Cultures in English. The AISCLI Summer School aims at widening the competence of postgraduate students (also those who wish to become teachers, educators, cultural mediators, translators), doctoral students and PhD holders in the field of postcolonial theories, literatures and cultures.

This wider perspective on African, Caribbean, Canadian, Pacific and Asiatic artistic and intellectual productions – in the form of poetry, prose, drama, music, figurative art, architecture and cinema – will be the focus of a series of lectures, seminars and workshops held by Italian academics, who are expert and have publications in those fields.

WHO CAN ATTEND:

All post-graduate students with a Degree in the Humanities can attend, or students who are taking their degree (3 years) between July and November. All PhD candidates, PhD students and PhD holders in the same field are welcome, too.

Students from University of Turin can have this Summer School recognized as "Tirocinio" (see further info on the web site).

LOCATION:

All the lectures and seminars will be held at Facoltà di Lingue e Letterature Straniere, Università di Torino, Sala Lauree. Via Verdi 10.

CERTIFICATION:

At the end of the course participants will get a Certificate of Attendance.

TUITION FEE/ VENUE:

Admission fee: 300 € VAT exempt for individuals or 300€ + VAT (21%) for professionals and companies.

For early registration (deadline 6 July 2012) it is possible to book an accommodation in single (207 €) or double room (136 €) at Residence Olimpia, Lungo Dora Siena 104, Torino.

Preference for single rooms should be indicated while booking. It is obvious that due to the limited number of single rooms available, later bookings will definitely be allocated to double rooms.
